Top 10 Wedding Flower Tips



1. Choose your bouquet and style first, it's the most important part of the wedding flowers. Have the best blooms in your bouquet, the rest will look amazing.
2. Be open about your budget from the start, it really helps both you and I decide on the best flowers for your wedding. We are happy to help give you guidance on the right flowers within your budget.
3. Flower prices fluctuate, especially in the summer season around Mother's Day and Valentine's. So, if you're getting married in the peak season it's likely that your flowers will be more expensive.
4. Don't get too caught up with trends, I know it's hard with Instagram and Pinterest, however keeping your flowers elegant and unique will mean you'll proudly show off the photos for many a year.
5. Choose and invest in your key pieces, this can be completely different for each couple so think about what is most important to you. The rest will slot in to place.

6. Where possible choose flowers that are in season. Choosing seasonal flowers and foliage helps create a classic and timeless look, that will never date and will highlight your venue perfectly.
7. Be open with me, floral design is what I do, show me 5-6 designs that you really like or dislike and let me come up with some ideas. Work with me collaboratively and you'll get great results.
8. I love Pinterest and use it daily for inspiration, but don't get too hung up on the photos, (I know it's hard) often they have been heavily filtered and are American where flower availability is totally different.
9. Try to get as much use as you can from your flowers, you can use church/ceremony flowers at your reception venue, I will move these for you at an extra charge - maybe get the Ushers involved?
10. Make the process fun, flowers are a great way of expressing you as a couple and shining through your personality. Go through your memories and highlights together and let me get creative.
